

Description

"TCF" means Curraghs Primer, a product specially used in curraghs base layer, he can share color paste with curraghs, based on the same configuration.

"MCP" means the material of Curraghs itself, a fluffy product that can be displayed in many ways.

The product itself does not mix any color system (meaning it appears white). The color itself is added and used externally. In Manntree's color matching system, this type of color paste is generally replaced by the letter "M", and all colors are inorganic color pastes.




















Unique "Curraghs " Art Paint

Curraghs" is a kind of "rare ferret" raised from the Curraghs Zoo Isle of Mann, Isle of man).

Out of respect for animal fur, we strongly condemn this ancient hunting behavior of randomly hunting and capturing animal fur. After consulting the professional advice of RSPCA, the Mantu team, It was decided to develop a novel way to obtain the necessary fine fur from errets without any harm to the animals themselves.

We are inspired by their fur texture, and in a very real way 100% eproduce the fur texture of ferrets. The top leather feel is its difference, which makes (curraghs) very popular in the UK, but also shows our awe of nature.










Characteristics:

water based interior wall material, very suitable for traditional building materials and plastering.

Technical description:

- ① Different batches of materials shall not be applied to the same wall.
- ② Colors may vary from batch to batch * and are only approximate.
- ③ The material already mixed with water should be used up within 24 hours.
- 4 When applied to non waterproof wall, waterproof super wax must be used.

Cleaning method:

Areas contaminated by fungal or algal growth should be treated with a special fungicide and cleaned thoroughly.











Features:

Manufactured under the leadership of ISO 9001:2015 quality and environmental management system.

- ① Smooth mink skin, top fur feel.
- ② The repaired surface: "curraghs" can accept some slight scratches and can be smoothed off after completion.
- ③ Marble material: it has a similar background to Carrara marble in the UK. They also have good luster and a variety of attractive colors, which makes "curraghs" recognized by many British families and used in their homes.

Base surface requirements:

- ① The cement mortar base needs to be maintained for more than 6 days, and the pH is less than 11 degrees
- ② Neutral putty can be directly applied after leveling, grinding and dust removal

Construction technology:

- ① Please stir "curraghs" well before use
- ② Brush the sealing primer evenly, and the bottom layer after brushing shall be completely waterproof
- ③ "Curraghs" can be properly added with about 10% water
- Apply 1-2 times in batch on the wall surface, and at least 4-6 hours interval for each time at normal room temperature
- ⑤ Before the second drying, use the tool to stack and batch, which makes it more hierarchical.

Avoid applying too much thickness as this will produce a weaker coating and may result in fine build-up.

Matters needing attention:

- 1) Please stir well before use.
- 2 Pay attention to the environmental critical point: the construction can not be carried out when the temperature is lower than 5 °C and the relative humidity is higher than 85%.

after drying for 24 hours, if waterproof treatment is needed, waterproof super wax can be selected.






















Wild paradise! Curraghs Wildlife Park

In the 1930s, the government tried to make Curraghs profitable by growing New Zealand flax.

The land was bought by the Isle of Man government in 1963, and the 26-acre Curraghs Wildlife Park opened two years later. A well-designed park cannot be called a zoo. These animals live in large enclosures designed with natural habitat as the concept. The paved path crosses the fence, where animals roam freely. Nature trails meander through different areas of Curraghs, where you can see butterflies, birds and other wetland insects and animals.

Animal ecosystem

"Curraghs" is a zoo on Mann Island (Mann), feeding various animals from all over the world. The area is considered important because it has a kind of cherished ferret that lives in Europe; a kind of ferret in winter Birds landing in the area. This Gulag Wildlife Park has been given a sacred function. The huge ecological system makes this 90-year-old park become the oldest wild ecological scenic spot on Mann Island


